**DECREE OF MODIFICATION FOR
HOLY INNOCENTS PARISH IN DUVALL**

To Rev. James O. Johnson, Jr., Pastor of Holy Innocents Parish in Duvall;
the pastors of the Eastside Deanery; and all concerned.

Whereas, the church of Holy Innocents in Duvall was established as a mission in 1913 and was elevated to a parish in 2004 to provide for the spiritual needs of that portion of the Christian faithful in the area; and

Whereas, the pastor of Holy Innocents Parish has been assigned the care of St. Anthony of Padua Church in Carnation, a subsidiary church without its own territorial boundaries; and

Whereas, I have heard from the Presbyteral Council on this matter at their meeting on September 17, 2025 in accordance with 515 §2.

Now, therefore, I hereby decree that the boundaries of Holy Innocents Parish be changed to include the city of Carnation. Effective today, the new boundaries are as follows:

- **North:** Beginning at the intersection of Hwy 522 and Echo Lake Rd in Snohomish County, proceed northeast along Hwy 522 to its intersection with the Snohomish River,
- thence southeast along the west bank of the Snohomish and Snoqualmie Rivers to the King-Snohomish County line,
- thence east along the King-Snohomish County line to the King-Chelan County line.
- **East:** South along the King-Chelan County line to its intersection with Latitude 47° 35' 13.8" N (SE 24th St & W River Rd north of Fall City, extended).
- **South:** West along Latitude 47° 35' 13.8" N from the King-Chelan County line to its intersection with State Route 202 (Redmond-Fall City Rd SE), just east of the intersection of 292nd Ave SE and State Route 202,
- thence north on State Route 202 (Redmond-Fall City Rd SE) to 236th Ave NE.
- **West:** North on 236th Ave NE as it becomes 238th Ave NE,
- thence north on 238th Ave NE to its intersection with NE 80th St,

- thence north on Redmond Ridge Dr NE to the intersection with NE Novelty Hill Rd,
- thence east along NE Novelty Hill Rd to the extension of the eastern-most boundary of the Redmond Watershed Preserve,
- thence north along the extended eastern-most boundary of the Redmond Watershed Preserve to NE 133rd St,
- thence east on NE 133rd St to 232nd Ave NE,
- thence north on 232nd Ave NE to its intersection with NE Old Woodinville Duvall Rd,
- thence west along NE Old Woodinville Duvall Rd to its intersection with NE Woodinville-Duvall Rd and NE 170th Pl,
- thence north on NE Woodinville-Duvall Rd to 222nd Way NE,
- thence north, extending beyond the road, across the county line to 143rd Ave SE at its intersection with Aspen Way (near Echo Lake in Snohomish County),
- thence northwest on Aspen Way to E Echo Lake Rd,
- thence east and north around the east side of Echo Lake on E Echo Lake Rd to Echo Lake Rd,
- thence north on Echo Lake Rd to Hwy 522, the point of beginning.

This boundary change also changes the corresponding territorial boundary shared with Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in Snoqualmie.

This decree must be communicated without delay to the pastor of Holy Innocents Parish in Duvall and Our Lady of Sorrows Parish in Snoqualmie and posted to the archdiocesan website.

All things to the contrary notwithstanding.
